

The following are general guidelines that will govern the presentations for the Z-Harmony Bachelor Auction. Please feel free to ask the Z-Harmony Planning Committee for clarification if needed.

Screenings

- All participants are required to meet with the Z-Harmony Planning Committee.
- Screening appointments will take place on Saturday, January 23rd at Cary Towne Center Food Court, which is located at 11105 Walnut Street, Cary, NC 27511.
- Screenings will be held in 15 minute intervals from 3:00pm-6:00pm.
- Appointments will be given on a first come, first served basis with two participants per time slot. To sign up, please send an email to zharmony@sigmarhozeta.org with your preferred times. Appointments cannot be scheduled by phone.
- Please plan to arrive at least 5 minutes prior to your appointment time.
- Please bring your musical selection (if any).

Auction Guidelines

- Participants should arrive at Carmen's Cuban Café & Lounge no later than 6:30pm on Saturday, February 6, 2010. After check-in, participants will be given a brief orientation. Please arrive already dressed for the pre-auction mixer.
- Participants are asked to dress business casual for the auction. More formal attire is welcomed. Please do not wear jeans, sneakers, Timbs, baseball caps, t-shirts, etc. During presentations, participants may not remove any articles of clothing other than a hat or jacket. Participants are welcomed to change clothes following the mixer; however, please keep in mind that space will be limited.
- Participants are encouraged to pick their own "theme music" to play in the background during their presentation to the audience. The selection cannot contain any lyrics that are explicit, vulgar, profane, degrading, or overly sexually suggestive. All selections must be approved in advance by the Z-Harmony Planning Committee. Please bring your selection with you for your screening appointment on Saturday, January 23, 2010. In the case that a participant does not choose a song, one will be selected for him by the Z-Harmony Planning Committee.
- Participants are encouraged to get the crowd involved with their presentations. For example, we welcome you to pass out roses (or other types of flowers) to the ladies in the audience. Items must be handed out, not thrown. Please refrain from going into the crowd or leaving the runway. Any such presentations to the audience must be simple and brief so as not to take away from the auctioneer's commentary.

Date Parameters

- Participants should contact their dates within 2 weeks after the event to make arrangements for an outing.
- The outing must be completed by April 30, 2010. The date may be later if both parties mutually agree.
- The outing must be held at a public place.
- An example of an outing would be dinner for two (averaging at least \$25) and an activity such as bowling or a movie. We encourage you to be creative as it is your creativity that will "get the bid!"
